36.4.i. Guidelines for "Interdisciplinary Project" of UG programmes (for more than 2 branch students).

The controller of examinations presented the following guidelines for the "Interdisciplinary projects" with participation of students from more than 2 branches:

- i) The team of Interdisciplinary project shall consist of maximum of 4 members, which can accommodate students from 2 or more number of branches.
- ii) Project Guide for students of a particular branch shall be allotted from the respective branch of the student(s); more than one project guide can be allotted to one Interdisciplinary project.
- iii) The number of project reviews, Attendance requirements, procedure for the award of Continuous Assessment marks and end semester examinations marks will be the same as regular project.
- iv) Interdisciplinary projects review committee shall be jointly constituted by the respective HOD's.

Constitution of Interdisciplinary Project review committee is as follows:

- Dept 1: Project guide of the department of the student(s) + One faculty nominated by the HOD concerned
- Dept 2: Project guide of the department of the student(s) + One faculty nominated by the HOD concerned.
- Dept N: Project guide of the department of the student(s) + One faculty nominated by the HOD concerned

(i) The following amendment is made in the clause 4.5.2:

"The student is allowed to go 4 weeks of Industrial Training/Internship only during the entire duration of study instead of maximum of 6 weeks".

36.4.ii.b. Additional Activity Points:

The following amendment is made in the clause 20.

"The required additional activity points should be earned by the students in his/her Second and Third year of study and the details shall be submitted to the Office of the Controller of Examinations in the beginning of seventh semesters (during the Registration) for printing in the grade sheet".

36.4.ii.c. Grouping of Open Elective Courses:

The open elective courses offered by B.E. / B.Tech. Programmes shall be grouped and marked as the course to be offered under OE1, OE2, OE3 and OE4 separately and shall be offered during that stipulated period only.
