  - 2.6 Funds of Rs. 84 lakhs have been allocated for building maintenance by Government.
  - 2.7 A new Geo Tech lab construction has been approved by Government for Rs. 77 lakhs.
  - 2.8 Additional construction of Toilets have been approved by Building Committee.
